With the help of Noel Perkins and John Gould they cleared the remaining timber and carpets ready for further use. The area will initially be used for composting weed cleared from streams.

LOCAL STREAM CLEAR Alan Pordage and family have cleared the stream by plot 14A, utilising the new facility to compost the bullrushes close by. This extends the section of stream opened up by Noel Perkins last year. It is hoped to clear the two remaining sections at each end of this waterway later in the year, to restore the active flow.
